

**School Improvement Plan Midyear Report
Adult & Community Education
January 30, 2008**

Student Progress Monitoring

Goal Area: Reading, Mathematics and Language

1. 600 literacy completion points (grade level improvement in reading, math and language) will be earned by ABE/ESOL students enrolling.
2. 370 literacy completion points were achieved by enrolled students from August – December, 2007. 62% of the performance goal set for this year has been achieved.
3. Based on this achievement for first semester, the performance goal should be reached by June 30, 2008.
4. Performance is on target.

Goal Area: Secondary Instruction (GED and Adult High School Credit)

1. 900 literacy completion points (1/2 credits earned and GED sub-tests passed) and 175 diplomas will be achieved by secondary students enrolling.
2. 346 literacy completion points were achieved by enrolled students from August –December, 2007. 38% of the literacy completion point goal and 62% of the diploma goal set for this year has been reached.
3. Since performance is usually greater second semester for secondary students, it is anticipated that both performance goals will be achieved by June 30, 2008.
4. Diplomas earned this year may exceed goal set; literacy completion points earned are behind target at this time.

Goal Area: Instruction for Adults with Disabilities and Senior Learners

1. 85% of the students enrolled in adults with disabilities and senior learner classes this year will achieve a minimum of 2 objectives on their Individual Adult Education Plan (IAEP).
2. Projected enrollment is 900 students. 82% of the enrollment goal has been reached. 3% of students enrolled August – December, 2007, have reached benchmark goals on their IAEP.
3. Based on past trends, most IAEP goals are achieved second semester. It is anticipated that enrollment will continue to increase with new classes second semester, and 85% or more students will achieve the two benchmarks set for this year.
4. For this population, performance is low at this time, but is on target based on past data.

Goal Area: Recruitment, Retention and Follow-up Adult Students

- 1. Maintain and/or increase enrollment in ACE classes above 2006-2007 (4,480).**
- 2. From August – December, 2007, 1,999 students enrolled in ACE classes. This is 45% of enrollment needed to reach the enrollment goal set for 2007-08.**
- 3. Based on prior years, enrollment usually increases second semester which includes summer school. However, enrollment has declined for the last 3 years.**
- 4. Enrollment must increase by June 30, 2008, in order to maintain enrollment in 2006-07. Enrollment is not on target to reach this goal.**
