Frequently Asked Questions about Registration

When is registration offered? Registration is offered Mondays on the ACE Campus at 1:30 p.m. and Tuesdays at the library at 5:30 p.m. Registration is open from August 2009 through April 2010. Please see Page 2 for more information.

Do I need to pre-register? No. Just attend the next available registration session.

How long will registration take? Registration will take approximately 3 hours. You will need to choose a class schedule, fill out registration papers, and take an assessment test.

When should I arrive? Please arrive early to avoid missing your assessment. Sorry, late students will not be admitted to the registration session. Registration will take the full 3 hours, so it is important to get started on time. Late students will be asked to attend the next available registration session.

What should I bring? Bring your address and phone number so your teacher can contact you if necessary. No documentation or proof of residency is needed to register.

When will I start classes? You should begin attending classes the next class day after registration.

What will my assessment scores be used for? ACE uses test scores for student placement, lesson planning, and to measure student progress.

What if I have more questions? Please ask the teacher during your registration session or call 922-5343.

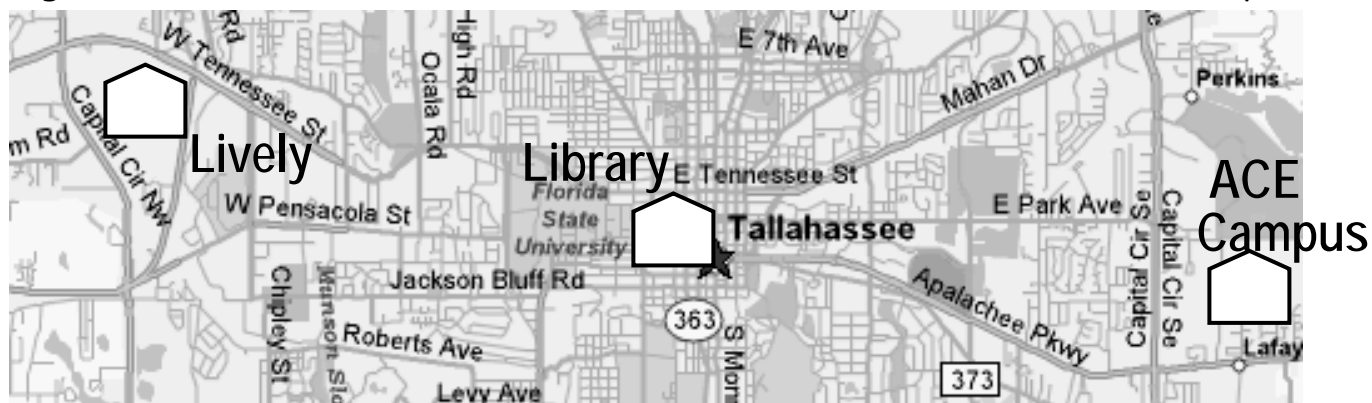

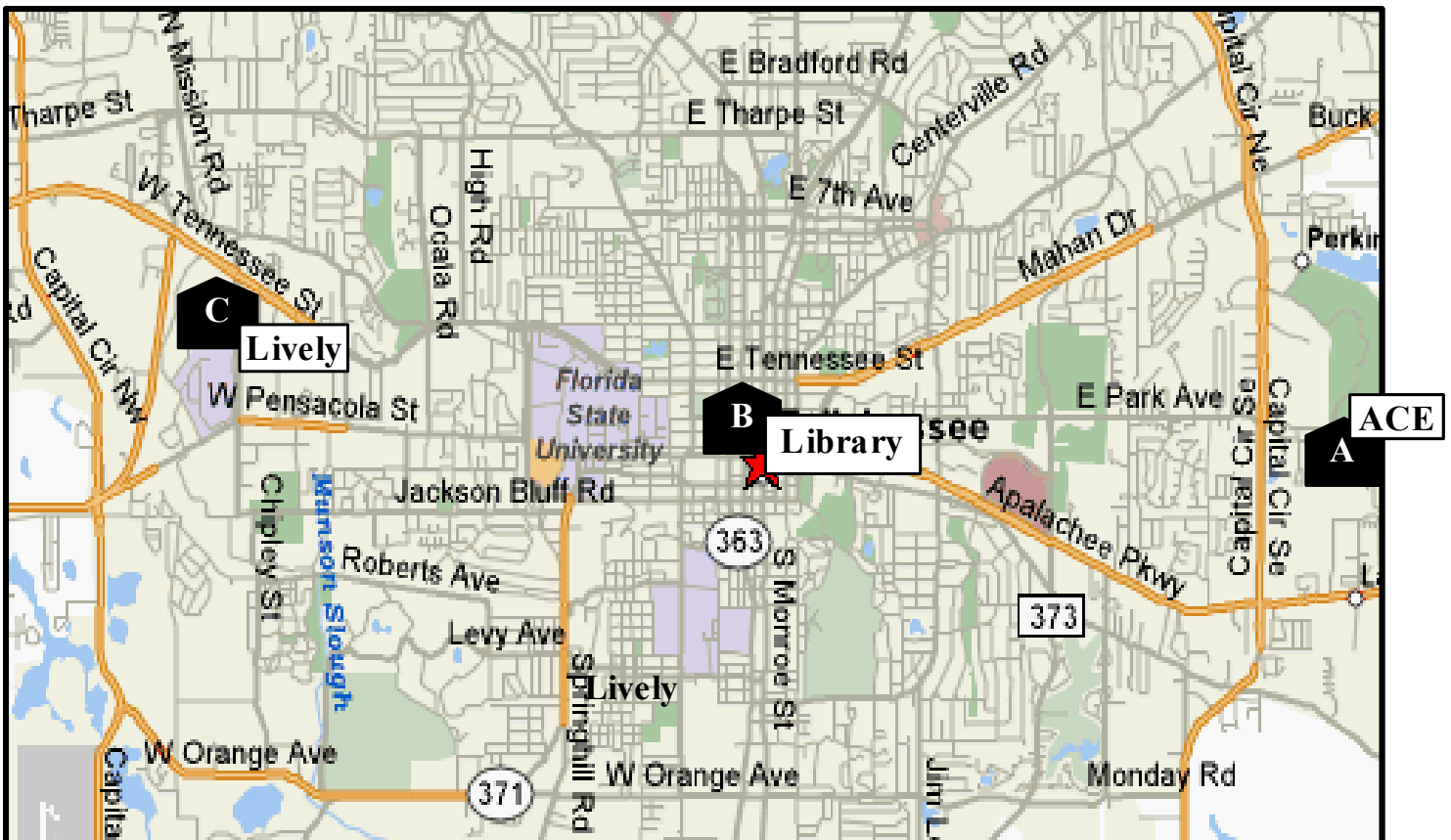

Frequently Asked Questions about the Classes

Am I eligible for enrollment? You must be at least 16 years old and enroll for a minimum of 1 month.

How do I enroll in English classes? Attend a registration session Monday afternoon at ACE or Tuesday evening at the library. A current address and phone number are all you need to bring.

What are my responsibilities as a student? Attend class regularly and arrive to class on time. Regular attendance is the key to getting the most benefit from our English classes.

How long can I study English with ACE? The 2009-2010 school year begins August 24, 2009 and continues until June 3, 2010. *Students who attend one semester or more will benefit the most from English classes.*

What kinds of skills will I learn? The classes will help you with listening, speaking, reading, writing, vocabulary, and grammar, as well as living and working in the U.S.

How many students will be in my class? The number of students in each class varies. The average number is 15.

How will I be evaluated? We regularly administer English listening and reading assessments to evaluate your progress.

Does ACE offer proof of enrollment? After each posttest you take, you will receive a certificate of enrollment for the semester. Letters of enrollment are available upon request as long as you have taken a posttest.

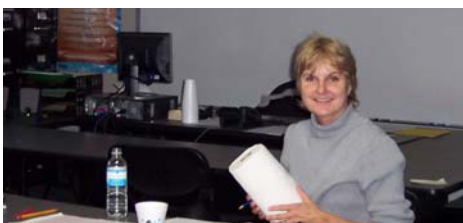

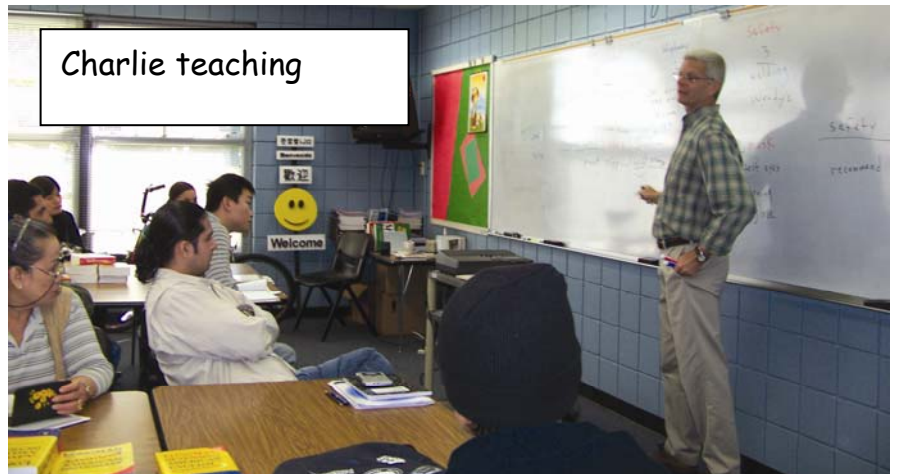

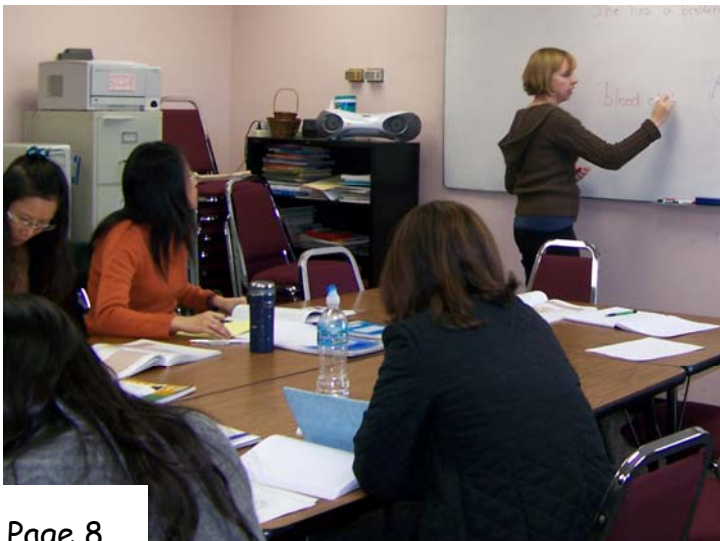

¿Soy elegible para la inscripción? Tiene que tener por lo menos de 16 años para inscribirse en la clase y inscribirse por lo mínimo de un mes.

¿Cómo me inscribo en la clase de inglés en Lively? La clase de lunes y miércoles en Lively es una clase especial. A diferencia de todas nuestras otras clases, puede matricularse usted directamente en la clase. Las clases empiezan el 24 de agosto y siguen hasta 3 de junio. Preséntese cualquier lunes o miércoles en Lively a las seis de la tarde para inscribirse.

¿Qué debo hacer si quiero estudiar inglés pero no puedo asistir los lunes y miércoles a las seis de la tarde? Ofrecemos otras clases con varios horarios. Con la excepción de la clase de lunes y miércoles en Lively, todas nuestras otras clases tienen un prerrequisito de inscripción. No se puede entrar directamente a ninguna otra clase sin prueba de inscripción. Se puede inscribir en los lunes a la 1:30 de la tarde en salón 310 del ACE Campus, y los martes a las 5:30 en el tercer piso del biblioteca central en 200 W. Park Avenue. Hay que llegar a tiempo a la inscripción-no se admitan estudiantes que lleguen tarde.

¿Cuáles son mis responsabilidades como estudiante? Atender clases y llegar a tiempo a las clases. Atender regularmente es la llave para beneficiar de nuestras clases de ingles.

¿Por cuánto tiempo puedo estudiar ingles con ACE? Las clases del semestre de otoño comienzan 24 de agosto del 2009 y continúan hasta 3 de junio del 2010.

सोमवार दोपहर को ACE में, या मंगलवार शाम को Leon County Library में होनेवाली पंजीकरण (registration session) में हाजिर होना है।

पंजीकरण के लिए मुझे क्या क्या लाना है?

Perguntas comuns

Como me inscrevo nas classes de inglês?

Atenda a uma sessão do registro na tarde de segunda-feira no ACE ou à noite de terça-feira na biblioteca pública do condado de Leon.

O que devo trazer para me registrar?

Você necessita somente fornecer-nos com seu endereço e número de telefone para que seu professor possa contatá-lo. Você terminará o formulário de registro e fará o exame de avaliação.

Quais são minhas responsabilidades como estudante?

Assistir à classe regularmente e no horário.

Quanto tempo posso estudar inglês com ACE?

O semestre do outono começará em agosto 20, 2007. O semestre da primavera continuará até maio 22, 2008. Mais de um semestre é recomendado para a maioria dos estudantes.

Que habilidades aprenderei?

“No person shall on the basis of gender, marital status, sexual orientation, race, religion, national origin, age, or disability be denied employment, receipt of services, access to or participation in school activities or programs if qualified to receive such services, or otherwise be discriminated against or placed in a hostile environment in any educational program or activity including those receiving Federal financial assistance, except as provided by law.”
