

## Adult Education Tuition Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Due to changes in state law, beginning July 1, 2011 anyone enrolling in adult classes ---ABE, GED, adult high school credit or ESOL---will be required to pay tuition.

How much does tuition cost?

***Term II and III are from January 5, 2012 to June 28, 2012. Term II is January 5 – May 31 and term III is June 4-June 28.***

*Florida residents:* If you can demonstrate you have lived in Florida for a year or more then tuition is \$47.25 for January 5 – June 28 regardless of how many classes you take.

*Non-Florida residents:* If you cannot demonstrate you have lived in Florida for a year or more then tuition is \$189.00 for terms II and III.

How do I know if I pay in-state or out-of-state tuition?

To pay in-state tuition you must bring two current forms of information to prove that you have lived in Florida for the last 12 months (a year). Examples include a Florida driver's license, Florida ID, a lease agreement or a Florida voter's registration. For a more detailed list, click [here](#).

When are the terms?

August – December (term 1)

January – May (term 2)

June (term 3)

When is tuition due?

Tuition is due at the time of registration.

How do I pay tuition?

You must pay your tuition in person at the ACE Campus or the Lively Technical Center Campus. The registration teacher will work with you on the amount of tuition you pay and give you the information on how to pay tuition. Tuition must be paid in cash or money order.

What if I have to drop the class?

During the first week of the originally scheduled orientation a student may withdraw and be entitled to a 100% refund. The student must bring the paid tuition receipt to the ACE Campus at 283 Trojan Trail. ACE campus business office hours are Monday-Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Fridays from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. It is the student's responsibility by the end of the first scheduled orientation class week to request the withdrawal if they no longer want to attend. Tuition WILL NOT be refunded if the student is withdrawn for disciplinary reasons.

Weren't these classes free before?

Yes. However, the Florida Legislature mandated tuition for all adult education students effective July 1, 2011.
